

BEP's Artificial Intelligence Policy

Purpose

Business Expert Press supports the responsible use of artificial intelligence (AI) as a limited editorial aid. However, manuscripts submitted for publication must reflect the author's own original intellectual work. AI may assist the writing process in a limited way, but it may not function as the author of the work.

Policy

1. **Human authorship is required**

All manuscripts submitted to Business Expert Press must be the original work of the named author(s). Manuscripts generated in whole or in substantial part by artificial intelligence are not acceptable for publication.

2. **Permitted use of AI**

Authors may use AI tools for limited assistance such as grammar correction, language refinement, copyediting support, or organizational suggestions.

3. **Prohibited use of AI**

Authors may not use AI tools to generate substantive content, including chapter text, analysis, interpretation, arguments, conclusions, case studies, or reference lists.

4. **Disclosure is required**

Any use of generative AI tools in the preparation of a manuscript must be disclosed at the time of submission.

5. **Author accountability**

Authors remain fully responsible for the accuracy, originality, and integrity of all content in the manuscript, including any material developed with AI assistance.

6. **Reference integrity**

All citations, references, quotations, and data must correspond to authentic, verifiable sources. Fabricated, misleading, or unverifiable references are grounds for rejection or withdrawal.

7. **AI may not be credited as an author**

AI tools or systems may not be listed as authors or co-authors and may not assume responsibility for the content of a manuscript.

Enforcement

If a manuscript is found to be generated primarily by AI, or to contain fabricated references, inaccurate source material, or undisclosed AI use, Business Expert Press may reject the manuscript, suspend review, or withdraw the work from publication.
